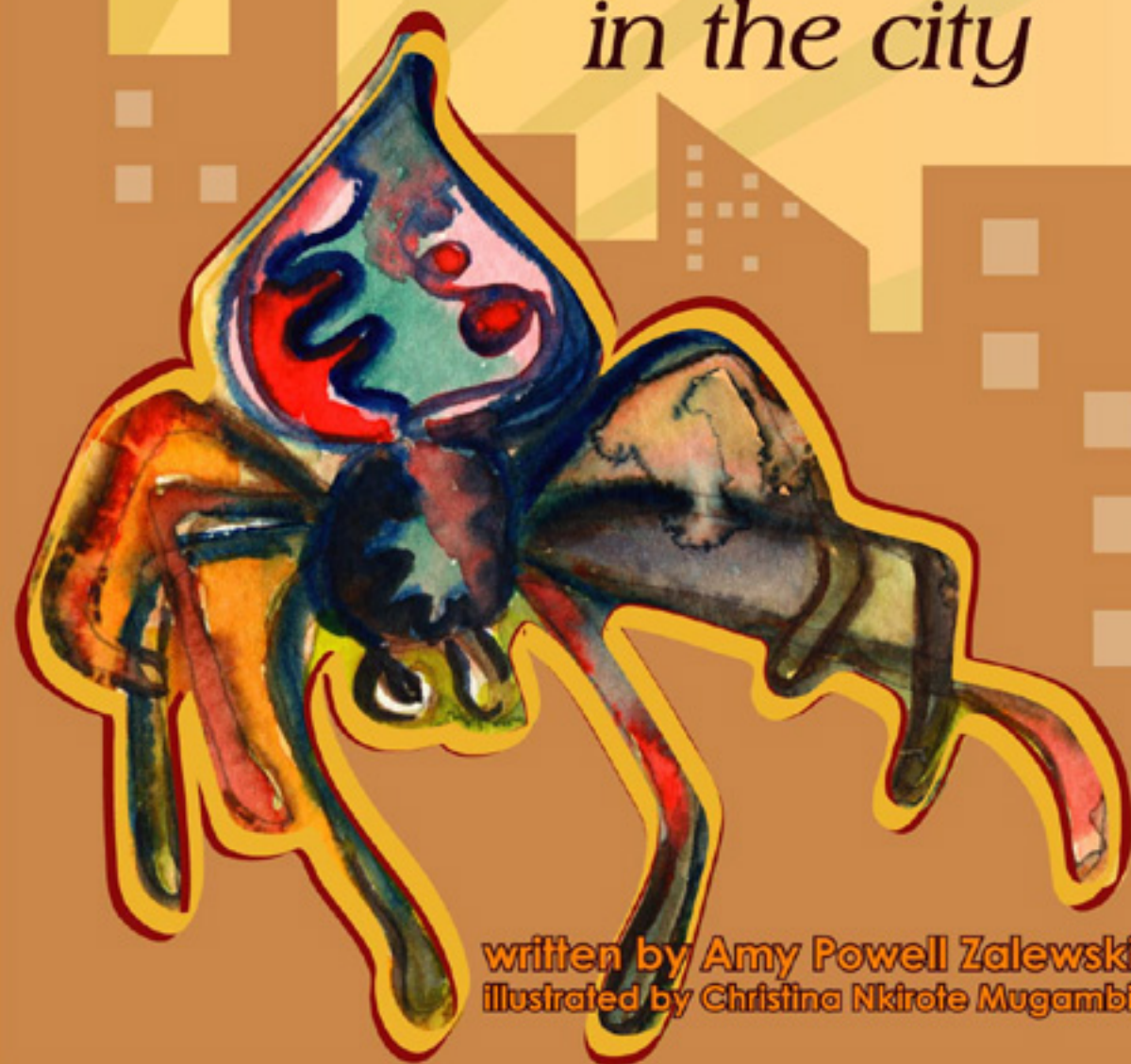
In Summer School In the City we are taught by an artistic spider, a do-nothing dog, some thirsty mosquitoes and many more.
